PUBLIC OFFICES) ACT (AMENDMENT TO  
SCHEDULE) ORDER, 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Judicial and Legal Service (Prescribed Public Offices) Act (Ch. 42), the Governor-General makes the following Order —

**1. Citation and commencement.**

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Judicial and Legal Service (Prescribed Public Offices) Act (Amendment to Schedule) Order, 2018.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2015.

**2. Amendment to Schedule of Ch. 42.**

The Schedule to the Judicial and Legal Service (Prescribed Public Offices) Act is amended by the deletion of the words “Director of Law Reform and Revision”, “Deputy Director of Law Reform and Revision” and “Assistant Director of Law Reform and Revision” and the corresponding words thereto and the replacement thereof of the following—
