**JUDGES' REMUNERATION AND PENSIONS ACT  
(CHAPTER 45)**

**JUDGES' REMUNERATION AND PENSIONS  
(ALLOWANCES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2017**

The Governor-General, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act (Ch. 45), makes the following Order —

**1. Citation.**

This Order may be cited as the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions (Allowances) (Amendment) Order, 2017.

**2. Revokes and replaces paragraph 2 of Sub. Leg. Vol.I., Ch. 45-3.**

Paragraph 2 of the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions (Allowances) Order is revoked and replaced by the following —

**“2. Accommodation.**

- (1) Every person who is the holder of a judicial office shall be entitled, in the case of —
  - (a) the Chief Justice, to a housing allowance of \$63,000.00 per annum with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2015; and
  - (b) any Justice, other than a Justice under sub-paragraph (a), to a housing allowance of \$50,000.00 per annum with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2015.
- (2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1)(b), where there is a subsisting lease between the Government of The Bahamas as tenant, and a third party, that provides for housing accommodation for a resident Justice, other than the Chief Justice, the Justice shall not receive a housing allowance of \$50,000.00 per annum during the term of the lease.”
