**JUDGES' REMUNERATION AND PENSIONS ACT  
(AMENDMENT TO SCHEDULE) ORDER, 2017**

The Governor-General, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act (Ch. 45), makes the following Order —

**1. Citation.**

This Order may be cited as the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act (Amendment to Schedule) Order, 2017.

**2. Revokes and replaces the Schedule to Ch. 45.**

The Schedule to the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act is revoked and replaced by the following —

**“SCHEDULE**

**(section 3)**

**SALARIES OF JUDGES**

There shall be paid —

- (a) with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2015 to —
  - (i) the Chief Justice, a salary of \$118,476.00 per annum;
  - (ii) any Senior Justice, a salary of \$111,545.00 per annum;
  - (iii) every other Justice, a salary of \$104,474.00 per annum; and
- (b) with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2017 to —
  - (i) the Chief Justice, a salary of \$120,253.00 per annum;
  - (ii) any Senior Justice, a salary of \$113,219.00 per annum;
  - (iii) every other Justice, a salary of \$106,041.00 per annum.”.
