HAWKSBILL CREEK, GRAND BAHAMA (DEEP WATER HARBOUR AND INDUSTRIAL AREA)

NOTIFICATION UNDER CLAUSE 2(13) OF THE AGREEMENT

It is hereby notified that in exercise of the right to name the private port at Hawksbill Creek in pursuance of the provisions of subclause (13) of Clause 2 of the Agreement dated the fourth day of August, A.D., 1955 and recorded on the Registry of Records of The Bahamas in Book 8 (New Series) at pages 447 to 479, The Grand Bahama Port Authority, Limited, on the 5th day of August 1955 notified the Colonial Secretary in writing that the name of such port is “Freeport”.
