**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT  
(CHAPTER 36)**

**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (MAJORITY RULE DAY, 2019)(OPENING  
OF SHOPS)NOTICE, 2019**

**WHEREAS** by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act (“the Act”) it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

**AND WHEREAS** the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January is appointed a public holiday under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Thursday, the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2019, the day celebrated as Majority Rule Day in 2019:

**NOW THEREFORE** in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice —

**1. Citation.**

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Majority Rule Day, 2019) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2019.

**2. Opening of shops on Majority Rule Day, 2019.**

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Thursday, the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2019, the day celebrated as Majority Rule Day in 2019.
