#### PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT (CHAPTER 36)

### PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (MAJORITY RULE DAY, 2020) (OPENING OF SHOPS) NOTICE, 2020

WHEREAS by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act ("the Act") it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

AND WHEREAS the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January is appointed a public holiday under the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020, the day commemorated as Majority Rule Day in 2020:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice -

1. Citation.

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Majority Rule Day, 2020) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2020.

#### 2. Opening of shops on Majority Rule Day, 2020.

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020, the day commemorated as Majority Rule Day.
