Infected Island.

Restriction on movement of propagative materials. 1. This Order may be cited as the Plants Protection (Restriction on the Movement of Seeds, Fruits, Plants and other Propagative Materials) (Citrus Canker) Order.

2. The island of Abaco in The Bahamas is hereby declared to be a place infected with the citrus canker disease.

3. No person shall remove from the island of Abaco in The Bahamas any seed, fruit, plant or other propagative material of a citrus plant.
