## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 220)

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (FIXED PENALTY) REGULATIONS, 2012

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 96A of the Road Traffic Act, makes the following regulations –

## 1. Citation.

These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) Regulations, 2012.

## 2. Fines for certain fixed penalty offences.

The fines payable for certain fixed penalty offences are set out in Part I of the Schedule.

#### Notice.

The notice pursuant to section 96A of the Road Traffic Act (*Ch. 220*) shall be in the Form set out in Part II of the Schedule.
