TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SCHOOL CROSSING PATROLS REGULATIONS

GN 141/1961 5 cf 1987 SI 65/2000

(SECTION 92)

[Commencement 8th July, 1961]

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Signs and School Crossing Patrols Regulations.

Short title.

2. When between the hours of eight in the morning and six in the evening a vehicle is approaching a place in the road where children, on their way to and from school, are crossing or seeking to cross the road, a school crossing patrol shall have power, by exhibiting a traffic sign of the form, plan and character shown in diagram 1 of the Schedule hereto to require the person driving or propelling the vehicle to stop it.

Powers of school crossing patrol.

- 3. (1) A person shall be required to stop a vehicle —
- (a) before reaching a school zone shown in the form in diagram 2 of the Schedule where children are crossing or seeking to cross so as not to stop or impede their crossing; and

Penalty for failure to stop. 5 cf 1987, s 2; SI 65/2000 Schedule

- (b) the vehicle shall not be put in motion again so as to reach the place in question so long as children are crossing or seeking to cross.
- (2) A person who fails to comply with these regulations commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of two hundred dollars and is liable in respect of any further or subsequent offence to a fine of five hundred dollars.
- **4.** (1) A school crossing patrol shall be a person appointed by the Controller of Road Traffic in consultation with the Commissioner of Police and the Director of Education to patrol in accordance with arrangements made under regulation 1 of these Regulations.

Appointment.

(2) For the purposes of these Regulations, where it is proved that a sign was exhibited by a school crossing patrol, it shall be presumed to be of a size, colour and type prescribed, or of a description authorised, under the foregoing provisions of these Regulations, unless the contrary is proved.


