## WILDLIFE CONSERVATION AND TRADE ACT (CHAPTER 205A)

### WILDLIFE CONSERVATION AND TRADE (PERMIT FEES) REGULATIONS, 2023

The Minister, in consultation with the Management Authority, and in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 29 and 39(a) of the Wildlife Conservation and Trade Act (Ch. 205A) hereby makes the following regulations —

#### 1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation and Trade (Permit Fees) Regulations, 2023.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2023.

#### 2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations —

- "CITES animal" means any animal species included in Schedules 1, 2, 3 4 and 5 of the Act and includes any derivative or product thereof;
- "CITES plant" means any plant species included in Schedules 1, 2, 3 4 and 5 of the Act and includes any derivative or product thereof.

#### 3. Export permit fees.

There shall be payable, in respect of an export permit under section 10 of the Act, the applicable fees shown in the *Schedule*.
