- 1. This Act may be cited as the Foreign Recruiting short title. Act.
- 2. In this Act "foreign state" includes any person or "Foreign persons exercising or assuming to exercise the powers of state" government in or over any country, colony, province or 42/1969 people beyond the limits of the Island.

4. The Minister may from time to time by general order General notified in the Gazette either prohibit recruiting for the prohibit service of any foreign state, or impose upon such recruiting or limit same. any conditions which he thinks fit.

5. The Minister may rescind or vary any order made Power to under this Act in such manner as he thinks fit.

6. Whoever in violation of the prohibition of the Minister Offences or of any condition subject to which permission to recruit this Act. may have been accorded—

(a) induces or attempts to induce any person to accept or agree to accept or to proceed to any place with a view to obtaining any commission or employment in the service of any foreign state; or

(b) knowingly aids in the engagement of any person so induced, by forwarding or conveying him or by advancing money or in any other way whatever, shall be guilty of a misdemeanour and shall on conviction thereof be liable to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding seven years, or to a fine to such amount as the Court thinks fit, or to both fine and imprisonment.

7. Any offence against this Act shall be triable in the Circuit Court for any parish of this Island in which the person accused may be found, or in which such offence may have been committed.
