AN ACT to Amend the Constables (Special) Act.

[ 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2008 ]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constables (Special) (Amendment) Act, 2008, and shall be read and construed as one with the Constables (Special) Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (1)(a)—

(i) by inserting in sub-paragraph (i) immediately before the word “on” the words “subject to sub-paragraph (iii),”;

- (ii) by renumbering sub-paragraph (iii) as sub-paragraph (iv);
- (iii) by inserting next after sub-paragraph (ii), the following as sub-paragraph (iii)—
  - “(iii) at his option, after completing not less than thirty years of service;”;
- (b) by inserting next after subsection (3) the following as subsection (4)—
  - “(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (i) (a) (iii) and section 39, the normal retirement age of any Special Constable is sixty years.”.
