AN ACT to Amend the Constitution of Jamaica to increase the maximum number of constituencies into which Jamaica shall be divided, for the purpose of election of members to the House of Representatives, from sixty to sixty-five.

[ *April 1, 2009* ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, in accordance with the provisions of section 49 of the Constitution of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Constituencies) (Amendment) Act, 2009, and shall be read and construed as one

Amendment of section 67 of the Constitution 2. Subsection (1) of section 67 of the Constitution is amended by deleting the word “sixty” and substituting therefor the word “sixty-five”.
