



AN ACT to Amend the Civil Aviation Act.

[4th day of August 2017]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Act, 2017, and shall be read and construed as one with the Civil Aviation Act (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”).

Short title and construction.

2. Section 6A of the principal Act is amended by inserting next after subsection (2) the following subsection—

“ (3) The revenues received from charges imposed under subsection (2) shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund within seven days after receipt.”

3. Section 6D of the principal Act is amended by deleting paragraph (f).

4. Section 6I of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (2), by deleting the word “Monies” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to subsection (3), monies”; and

(b) inserting next after subsection (2), the following subsection—

“ (3) Monies standing to the credit of the Authority shall not include revenue payable to the Consolidated Fund under section 6A(3).”.
