AN ACT to Amend the Constabulary Force Act.

[ *August 8, 2002* ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constabulary Force (Amendment) Act, 2002, and shall be read and construed as one with the Constabulary Force Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 56 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (1) (a)—

(i) by inserting in sub-paragraph (i) immediately before the word “on” the words “subject to sub-paragraph (iii),”;

(ii) by deleting the word “or” at the end of sub-paragraph (ii) and by inserting new sub-paragraph (iii) thereafter the following as sub-paragraph (iii)—

“(iii) at his option, after completing not less than thirty years of service; or”;

(b) by renumbering subsection (4) as subsection (5);

(c) by inserting immediately after subsection (3), the following—

“(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) (a) (iii) and of section 57, the normal retiring age of any Constable shall be sixty years.”.
