AN ACT to Amend the Fire Brigade Act.

[1st July, 2008]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Fire Brigade (Amendment) Act, 2008, and shall be read and construed as one with the Fire Brigade Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

- (a) in paragraph 1, by deleting the words “seven” and “five” and substituting therefor the words “eleven” and “seven”, respectively;
- (b) in paragraph 8(4), by deleting the word “three” and substituting therefor the word “five”.
