AN ACT to Amend the Jamaica Maritime Institute Act so as to change the name of the Act and of the Jamaica Maritime Institute established thereunder and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

[*15th February, 2001*]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Jamaica Maritime Institute (Change of Name and Amendment) Act, 2001, and shall be read and construed as one with the Jamaica Maritime Institute Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Amendment of references to Jamaica Maritime Institute in principal Act.

2. The principal Act is hereby amended by—

- (a) deleting from the title and sections 1, 2 and 3 (1) the word “Jamaica” and substituting therefor in each case the word “Caribbean”;
- (b) deleting from section 18 the words “Jamaica Maritime Institute” and substituting therefor the words “Caribbean Maritime Institute”.

Amendment of section 4 of principal Act.

3. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the principal Act is hereby amended in paragraph (e) by deleting the word “Jamaica” and substituting therefor the words “the Caribbean region”.

Amendment of section 8 of principal Act.

4. Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby amended by—

- (a) relettering paragraph (e) as paragraph (f); and
- (b) inserting the following as paragraph (e)—
 - “(e) such sums as may be contributed by any regional or international body;”.

Amendment of Schedule to principal Act.

5. The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended in paragraph 1 (b) by—

- (a) deleting the word “ten” and substituting therefor the word “twelve”;
- (b) deleting the full stop at the end of paragraph (vi) and substituting therefor a semicolon; and
- (c) inserting the following as paragraph (vii)—
 - “(vii) two members shall be appointed from among persons appearing to the Minister to be representative of the interests of maritime or trade associations within the Caribbean region.”.
