AN ACT to Amend the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act.

[ *May 29, 2001* ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2001 and shall be read and construed as one with the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 119A of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1);
  - (b) by inserting next after subsection (1) as renumbered, the following as subsection (2)—  

“ (2) For the purposes of any arrangements which may be made for providing a pension scheme for Councillors, the basic allowance paid to Councillors with effect from the 1st of January, 1986 to the 15th of November, 1995, shall be deemed to be payment of salary.”
