AN ACT to Postpone the holding of a General Election under the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act and for purposes connected therewith.

[July 20, 2001]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation General Election (Postponement) Act, 2001, and shall be read and construed as one with the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

Short title

2. During the continuance in force of this Act, the principal Act shall be read and construed as if there were substituted for subsection (1) of section 8, the following subsection—

“ (1) A general election of councillors to serve on the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation shall be held on

such day or days not earlier than the 30th day of November, 2001, and not later than the 31st day of March, 2002, as the Governor-General in Council may by proclamation appoint.”.

**Duration
of Act.**

3. This Act shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 2002, and shall then expire.
