AN ACT to Postpone the holding of a General Election under the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act and for purposes connected therewith.

[30th June, 2006]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation General Election (Postponement) Act, 2006, and shall be read and construed as one with the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. During the continuance in force of this Act, the principal Act shall be read and construed as if there were substituted for subsection (1) of section 14, the following subsection—

“ (1) A general election of members to serve on the Council of the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation shall be held in the Corporate Area on such day or days not later than the 31st day of December, 2006, as the Governor-General in Council may by Proclamation appoint.”

Duration of
Act

3. This Act shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 2006, and shall then expire.
