## AN ACT to Amend the Larceny Act. [ 25th July, 2000 ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Larceny (Amendment) Short title Act, 2000, and shall be read and construed as one with struction. the Larceny Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Sections 48, 49, 50 and 51 of the principal Act are amended by deleting the words "two thousand" wherever they appear and substituting therefor in each case the words principal "forty thousand".
