AN ACT to Amend the Loan Act.

[*30th March, 2007*]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan (Amendment) Act, 2007, and shall be read and construed as one with the Loan Act, 1964, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. The principal Act is amended by deleting from the long title thereof and from section 2, respectively, the words “six hundred and fifty billion” wherever they appear and substituting therefor, in each case, the words “seven hundred billion”.
