AN ACT to Amend the Loan Act.

[31st December, 2008]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan (Amendment) Act, 2008, and shall be read and construed as one with the Loan Act, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto. Short title and construction.

2. The principal Act is amended by deleting from the long title and from section 2, respectively, the words "seven hundred billion" wherever they appear and substituting therefor, in each case, the words "nine hundred and twenty billion". Amendment of long title and section 2 of principal Act.
