AN ACT to Repeal the Minimum Business Tax Act.

[*1st day of January 2019*]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Minimum Business Tax (Repeal) Act, 2019.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2019.

2. The Minimum Business Tax Act is repealed.

3.—(1) A specified taxpayer who has paid the minimum business tax, whether in whole or in part, in accordance with the Minimum Business Tax Act (hereinafter referred to as the “repealed Act”) for the year of assessment commencing on the 1st day of January, 2019, is entitled to a refund of the tax, unless the specified taxpayer is in arrears for the payment of the minimum business tax for a previous year of assessment or otherwise has an outstanding income tax liability.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the phrases “minimum business tax”, “specified taxpayer” and “year of assessment”, shall be construed in accordance with the provisions of the repealed Act.
