AN ACT to Temporarily Amend the Noise Abatement Act.

[13th day of December 2019]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Noise Abatement (Temporary Amendment) Act, 2019, and, during the period referred to in section 2, shall be read and construed as one with the Noise Abatement Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2.—During the period from the date of commencement of this Act to the 31st day of January, 2020, the principal Act is amended—

(a) in section 3, by deleting subsection (4) and substituting therefor the following—

“ (4) The period referred to in subsection (1) is between 2 o’clock and 6 o’clock, in the morning.”;

(b) in section 5(3), by deleting the words “2 o’clock” and substituting therefor the words “4 o’clock”.

Effect on

3. Notwithstanding anything otherwise specified in any permission granted under section 5, the periods specified in sections 3(4) and 5(3) of the principal Act shall apply to any activity carried on pursuant to such permission, during the period referred to in section 2.
