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AN ACT to Amend the Nurses and Midwives Act.

[April 8, 2005 BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

1. This Act may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Short title and con-(Amendment) Act, 2005, and shall be read and construed as one struction. with the Nurses and Midwives Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended—

by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical sequence the section 2 of princi-(a) following-

> "assistant nurse" means a person who, having been admitted to an assistant nursing programme authorized and duly recognized by the appropriate regulatory body, has successfully completed the prescribed programme of studies, has acquired the necessary qualifications and is enrolled and

(2) The Council may, at any time if it thinks just, direct that a licence which has been revoked be reinstated on such conditions as it thinks fit.

(3) The Council shall, as soon as practicable after—

- (a) the licence of any person has been revoked; or
- (b) the reinstatement of any licence which has been revoked,

cause notice of the appropriate fact to be published in the *Gazette*.

(4) Where a licence issued to any person under this Act has been revoked, the Council may, in writing, require such person to return the licence to the Registrar and such person shall comply with that requirement.".

55.—(1) Every person who is registered or enrolled prior to the prescribed date shall, within three months after that date, apply to the Registrar for a licence and pay the fee of two thousand dollars.

(2) An application under paragraph (1) shall be in the form specified as Form I in the Fourth Schedule and the licence issued pursuant thereto shall be in the form specified as Form II in that Schedule.

(3) Every person who employs a nurse, a midwife or an enrolled nurse who is not licensed under the Act commits an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction before a Resident Magistrate to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars.

(4) In this regulation "prescribed date" means the date determined by the Council.

56.—(1) Every person who is licensed under the Act shall, not later than thirty days before the date of expiration of that licence—

- (a) apply to the Council for renewal of the licence in the form specified as Form I in the Fourth Schedule;
- (b) satisfy the Council that she has participated in the prescribed continuing education programme; and
- (c) pay the fee of two thousand dollars.

(2) An applicant under paragraph (1) shall be issued with a licence in the form specified as Form II in the Fourth Schedule. .
