AN ACT to Amend the National Housing Trust Act.

[ 25th day of August, 2005 ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Housing Trust (Amendment) Act, 2005, and shall be read and construed as one with the National Housing Trust Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by deleting paragraph (a) of subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following—

“(a) to provide finance for—

- (i) development projects undertaken by the Trust pursuant to sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1);

- (ii) social services and physical infrastructure for communities developed under the projects;”.

3.—(1) During the continuance in force of this section, section 4 of the principal Act shall have effect as if next after subsection (1) the following were inserted as subsection (1A)—

“ (1A) In addition to the functions specified in subsection (1), the Trust may provide financing up to a maximum amount in the aggregate of five billion dollars for projects for the development of education.”.

(2) This section shall continue in force for one year after the commencement of this Act and shall then expire.”.

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
