AN ACT to Amend the Constitution of Jamaica.

[ 24th September, 2002 ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and in accordance with the provisions of section 49 of the Constitution of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Oath of Allegiance and Judicial Oath (Constitutional Amendment) Act, 2002 and shall be read and construed as one with the Constitution of Jamaica (hereinafter referred to as the Constitution) and all amendments thereto.

2. The First Schedule to the Constitution is amended—

- (a) by deleting the Oath of Allegiance and substituting therefor the following—

“ *Oath of Allegiance*

I, ....., do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Jamaica, that I will uphold and defend the Constitution and the laws of Jamaica and that I will conscientiously and impartially discharge my responsibilities to the people of Jamaica. So help me God.”;

- (b) by deleting the Judicial Oath and substituting therefor the following—

“ *Judicial Oath*

I, ....., do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Jamaica, that I will uphold and defend the Constitution of Jamaica and that I will administer justice to all persons alike in accordance with the laws and usages of Jamaica without fear or favour, affection or ill will. So help me God.”.
