1. This Act may be cited as the Professional Engineers Registration short title (Amendment) Act, 2005, and shall be read and construed as one and with the Professional Engineers Registration Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

 - " (2) For the purposes of this Act, a person is a national of a Member State of the Caribbean Community if that person is—
 - (a) a citizen of that state; or
 - (b) has a connection with that state of a kind which entitles him to be regarded as belonging to or, if it be so expressed, as being a native or resident of the state for the purposes of the laws thereof relating to immigration.".
- 3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by-
 - (a) deleting from paragraph (a) the words "citizen of Jamaica" and substituting therefor the words "national of Jamaica or of another Member State";
 - (b) deleting from sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (c) the word "Jamaica" and substituting therefor the words "Jamaica or in any Member State".

4. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting from paragraph (a) the words "or a citizen of Jamaica" and substituting therefor the words ", a national of Jamaica or a citizen of another Member State".
