AN ACT to Amend the Pensions (Superannuation Funds and Retirement Schemes) Act.

[April 8, 2005]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preliminary

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Superannuation Funds and Retirement Schemes) (Amendment) Act, 2005, and shall be read and construed as one with the Pensions (Superannuation Funds and Retirement Schemes) Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 5 of the principal Act are amended by inserting therein, immediately before the words “under this Act” wherever they appear, the words “or registered as a trustee”.
