AN ACT to Amend the Praedial Larceny (Prevention) Act
[25th July, 2000]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Praedial Larceny (Prevention) (Amendment) Act, 2000, and shall be read and construed as one with the Praedial Larceny (Prevention) Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Subsections (1) and (3) of section 11 and subsection (8) of section 14 of the principal Act are amended by deleting the words "two thousand" wherever they appear and substituting therefor in each case the words "forty thousand".

3. Sections 15, 16 and 19 of the principal Act are amended by deleting the words "one thousand" wherever they appear and substituting therefor in each case the words "twenty thousand".
