AN ACT to Amend the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act.

[14th March, 2000]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Amendment) Act, 2000, and shall be read and construed as one with the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

Short title
and construction.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

(a) by deleting paragraph 1 and substituting therefor the following—

“Constitu-
tion of the
Council.

1. The Council shall consist of such number of members as shall be appointed by the Minister, as follows—

- (a) one shall be nominated by the Medical Association of Jamaica;
- (b) one shall be nominated by the Faculty of Medical Sciences of the University of the West Indies;
- (c) two shall be chosen by the Minister; and
- (d) such other persons as may be chosen by the Minister, each of whom shall represent one of the specified professions.”.

(b) in paragraph 10 by deleting sub-paragraph (4) and substituting therefor the following—

“(4) The quorum of the Council shall not be less than one-half of the membership.”.
