AN ACT to Amend the Property Tax Act.

[22<sup>nd</sup> April 2008]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Property Tax (Amendment) Act, 2008, and shall be read and construed as one with the Property Tax Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "fifty" and substituting therefor the words "six hundred".

3. The principal Act is amended by deleting the First Schedule and substituting therefor the following as the First Schedule—
