AN ACT Further to Amend the Road Traffic Act.

[24th September, 2002]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 2002 and shall be read and construed as one with the Road Traffic Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in the marginal note, by inserting next after the word “Fund” where it last appears the words “and the Road Maintenance Fund”;

- (b) by deleting from subsection (1) the words “subsection (2)” and substituting therefor the words “subsections (2) and (3)”; and
- (c) by inserting next after subsection (2) the following as subsection (3)—

“ (3) An amount equivalent to 33¼ per cent of licence duties on motor vehicles shall be paid into or accrue to the Road Maintenance Fund established under the Road Maintenance Fund Act.”.
