AN ACT to Amend the Road Traffic Act, 2018.

[5th August 2022]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act, short title 2022, and shall be read and construed as one with the Road Traffic and construction. Act, 2018 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by deleting subsection (1)(e) and substituting therefor the following—
"(e) motor cycles, that is to say, motor vehicles with fewer than four wheels and any other vehicle constructed so as to be steered by handlebars with the driver sitting astride the vehicle, with an unladen weight not exceeding 400 kilogrammes;".
3. Subsection (2)(c) of section 12 of the principal Act is amended by—
(a) deleting the word "Act"; and
(b) deleting the quotation mark and fullstop as it occurs a second time.
4. Subsection (1)(a)(iii) of section 13 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "registration certificate" and substituting therefor
