

AN ACT to Amend the Trade Act.

[13th October 2009]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Act, 2009, and shall be read and construed as one with the Trade Act (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto.

Short title
and con-
struction.

2. Section 10(1)(c) of the principal Act is amended by—

(a) inserting immediately after the words "may provide" the words "that, subject to affirmative resolution,"; and

(b) deleting the words—

(i) "three thousand dollars" and substituting therefor the words "two million dollars"; and

- (ii) “twelve months” and substituting therefor the words “two years”.”.

3. Section 13(1) of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words—

- (a) “three thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “two million dollars”; and
- (b) “twelve months” and substituting therefor the words “two years”.

Amendment
of section 14
of principal
Act.

4. Section 14(2) of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words “two thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “one million dollars”.

Amendment
of section 17
of principal
Act.

5. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words—

- (a) “two hundred dollars” and substituting therefor the words “two million dollars”; and
- (b) “three months” and substituting therefor the words “two years”.

Amendment
of section 18
of principal
Act.

6. Section 18 of the principal Act is amended by—

- (a) renumbering the section as subsection (1) of the section; and
- (b) inserting next after subsection (1) as renumbered the following as subsection (2)—

“ (2) Regulations made under this section may provide in respect of a breach of any of the provisions thereof for the imposition, subject to affirmative resolution, of a penalty on summary conviction in a Resident Magistrate’s Court of a fine not exceeding two million dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or of both such fine and imprisonment.”.

7. The principal Act is amended by inserting next after section 18 the following as section 18A—

“Minister may increase monetary penalty. 18A. The Minister may, by order, subject to affirmative resolution increase the monetary penalties specified in this Act.”.

Insertion of new section 18A in principal Act.

8. Regulation 37 of the Trade (Scrap Metal) Regulations, 2007, is amended by deleting the words—

- (a) “three thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “two million dollars”; and
- (b) “twelve months” and substituting therefor the words “two years”.

Amendment of the Trade (Scrap Metal) Regulations, 2007.
