AN ACT to Amend the Trafficking in Persons (Prevention, Suppression and Punishment) Act.

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act, may be cited as the Trafficking in Persons (Prevention, Short title Suppression and Punishment) (Amendment) Act, 2021, and shall be read and construed as one with the Trafficking in Persons (Prevention, Suppression and Punishment) Act (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto.

Amendment of section 4 of

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended in subsections (6), (7), (8) and (8A) by deleting the words "to a fine or" and "or to both such principal Act. fine and imprisonment", wherever they appear.

Amendment of section 5 ٥f principal Act.

- 3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended
 - in subsection (1) by deleting the words "to a fine or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twenty years or to both such fine and imprisonment" and substituting therefor the words "to the fine specified in sub-section (2)";
 - (b) by deleting subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following-
 - (2) Where the court is satisfied that a director, manager, secretary or other similar officer concerned with the management of a body corporate, having regard to the nature of functions in that capacity and to all the circumstances
 - connived in the commission of an offence under subsection (1), to a term of imprisonment not exceeding twenty years;
 - failed to exercise all diligence to prevent the commission of the offence under subsection (1), to a fine.

Amendment of section 15 of

4. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "two hundred and fifty thousand" and substituting therefor the words principal Act. "one million".

Amendment of section 17 of principal Act.

- 5. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended
 - by deleting the marginal note and substituting therefor the following—

"Amendment of monetary penalties."; and

in subsection (1), by deleting the words "increase the fines" and substituting therefor the words "amend the monetary penalties".

6. Section 10 of the Child Care and Protection Act is amended in Amendment subsection (2), by deleting the words "to a fine or" and "or to both fine of section 10 of the Child and imprisonment."
