

THE BICYCLES (CONTROL OF SECOND-HAND) ACT

REGULATIONS
(under section 15)THE BICYCLES (SECOND-HAND) (CONTROL) REGULATIONS, 1947
(Made by the Governor on the 31st day of December, 1947)

L.N. 91/47

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Bicycles (Second-hand) (Control) Regulations, 1947.

2. The form of application for a licence to deal in second-hand bicycles and second-hand bicycle parts or to repair bicycles shall be in the Form A in the Schedule.

Form A.

3. The form of licence to deal in second-hand bicycles and second-hand bicycle parts or to repair bicycles shall be in the Form B in the Schedule.

Form B.

4.—(1) Every person licensed under the Act to deal in second-hand bicycles and second-hand bicycle parts shall keep a purchase book and a sales book in which he shall record from day to day every purchase and every sale of a second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part made by him.

(2) Every person licensed under the Act to repair bicycles shall keep a book in which he shall record from day to day all repairs effected by him.

(3) Every purchase book shall specify—

- (a) the make and serial number of the second-hand bicycle purchased;
- (b) the name and address of the person from whom the second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part was purchased;
- (c) the hour and date at which the purchase was made;
- (d) whether the vendor was known or identified to the licensee;

- (e) the name and address of the person identifying such vendor where the vendor was identified;
 - (f) the price paid for the second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part.
- (4) Every sales book shall specify—
- (a) the name and address of the person to whom the second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part was sold;
 - (b) the make and serial number of the second-hand bicycle sold;
 - (c) the hour and date at which the sale was made;
 - (d) the price paid for the second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part;
 - (e) the date upon which the second-hand bicycle or second-hand bicycle part was purchased by the licensee and the name and address of the person from whom it was purchased.
- (5) Every repair book shall specify—
- (a) the make and serial number of the second-hand bicycle taken in for repair;
 - (b) the name and address of the person who engaged the services of the licensee to repair the bicycle;
 - (c) the hour and date at which the bicycle was delivered to the licensee;
 - (d) full particulars of the repairs done to the bicycle;
 - (e) whether the person who delivered the bicycle to the licensee was known or was identified to him;
 - (f) the name and address of the person identifying the owner or person who delivered the bicycle to the licensee where the owner or person who delivered the bicycle to the licensee was identified.
