THE DISTRICT CONSTABLES (RATES OF PAY) REGULATIONS, 1944

(Made by the Governor in Privy Council on the 9th day of December, 1944)

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the District Constables (Rates of Pay) Regulations, 1944.
 - 2. In these Regulations-

"day" means the period between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m.;

"night" means the period between 6. p.m. and 6 a.m.

- 3. Subject to the provisions of regulation 4 every district constable shall receive one dollar sixty cents in respect of—
 - (a) any day upon which he performs any duty or duties;
 - (b) any night in which he performs any duty or duties.
- 4. Where any district constable performs any duty or duties in any day and also performs any duty or duties in any night immediately preceding or succeeding such day, he shall receive two dollars in respect of the duties performed in such day and night.
