THE DEPORTATION (COMMONWEALTH CITIZENS) (FORMS) REGULATIONS, 1943

(Made by the Governor in Privy Council on the 16th day of L.N. 5/43 January, 1943)

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Deportation (Commonwealth Citizens) (Forms) Regulations, 1943.
- 2. The certificate of conviction and recommendation by the Court referred to in sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 1 in the Schedule.
- 3. A deportation order made under section 3 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 2 in the Schedule.
- 4. A restriction order made under section 4 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 3 in the Schedule.

- 5. A security order made under section 5 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 4 in the Schedule.
- 6. The notice required by section 7 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 5 in the Schedule.
- 7. A warrant for arrest issued under subsection (2) of section 7 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 6 in the Schedule.
- 8. A warrant for detention made under section 9 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 7 in the Schedule.
- 9. The orders for detention made under subsections (2), (3) and (4), respectively, of section 11 of the Act shall be in the forms set out as Forms 8, 9 and 10 in the Schedule.

- Form 11. 10. An order to the Master of a ship made under subsection (6) of section 11 of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 11 in the Schedule.
 - 11. Where in the circumstances of any case it is necessary that any of the forms set out in the Schedule should be varied, such forms as so varied shall be deemed to comply with the provisions of these Regulations and no such variation in any such form shall have the effect of invalidating any act done or proceedings taken under the Act.
