- 1. This Order may be cited as the Spirit Licence (Noxious or Detrimental Substance) Order, 1931.
- 2. The use by any person of certain liquors or ingredients commonly called or known as 'Oil of Gin', 'Oil of Cognac', 'Essence of Brandy' and 'Essence of Whisky' and other flavouring essences, substances or ingredients of a similar character or composition or of any substance containing higher alcohols or compound ethers or aldehydes or terpenes in the preparation of or mixture with any alcoholic liquor for sale with the exception of rum used for blending with other rum and to be sold as such shall be and is hereby prohibited unless the same shall be of a brand to be approved by the Minister.
- 3. The use by any person of the substance, liquor or ingredient G.N. 387/34 commonly known as Methyl Alcohol or of any essence or substance containing Methyl Alcohol, in the preparation of or mixture with any alcoholic liquor for sale is hereby prohibited.
