

MAGISTRATE'S COURT (VALIDATION) BILL 2014

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Magistrate's Court (Validation) Bill validates any act done by Desiree D. Furlonge and Eveline D. Chambers in the performance or purported performance of their functions and duties as Clerks of the Magistrate's Court.

Clause 1 sets out the short title of the Bill.

Clause 2 validates any act done by Desiree D. Furlonge in the performance or purported performance of her functions and duties as Clerk of the Magistrate's Court under the Magistrate's Court Act (Cap. 2.02) from 1 February 2006 to the commencement of the proposed Magistrate's Court (Validation) Act.

It also validates any act done by Eveline D. Chambers in the performance or purported performance of her functions and duties as Clerk of the Magistrate's Court under the Magistrate's Court Act (Cap. 2.02) from 1 April 2012 to the commencement of the proposed Magistrate's Court (Validation) Act.

Clause 3 repeals the Magistrate's Court (Validation) Act (No. 19 of 2013).
