AN ACT TO SANCTION CERTAIN PAYMENTS FROM THE CONSOLIDATED AND DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE SUMS PROVIDED BY LAW FOR THE SERVICES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MONTSERRAT FOR THE PERIOD ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH, 2015.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Montserrat and by the Authority of the same as follows:—

#### 1. Short title and commencement

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No. 3/2014) of 2015, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April 2014.

## 2. Authorisation of Expenditure

The various sums of money set forth in Part A and B of the Schedule to this Act, totalling one million seven hundred and seventy-eight thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,778,600) in addition to the sums granted by the Appropriation Act 2014 (No. 4 of 2014), are hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from the consolidated fund of Montserrat, and the Accountant General is hereby authorised and required from time to time upon the authority of warrants issued under the hand of the Minister of Finance to pay the sums set out in the Schedule to several services mentioned as the warrants may direct out of the consolidated fund of Montserrat without further order or formality.
