BIS-SAHHA tas-setgħat mogħtija lilu bl-artikoli 30 (5) u 31 (6) ta' l-Att dwar l-Edukazzjoni (Kap. 327), il-Kanċillier ta' l-Universita' ta' Malta ppromulga dawn ir-regolamenti magħmula mis-Senat ta' l-Universita' ta' Malta bis-sahha tas-setgħat mogħtija lilu bl-artikoli 31 u 35 ta' dak l-Att:

Titolu

1. Dawn ir-regolamenti jistgħu jissejħu r-Regolamenti ta' l-2003 biex jemendaw ir-Regolamenti tal-Kors għall-Grad ta' Master of Business Administration - M.B.A. - Executive Master of Business Administration - Executive M.B.A. - u Executive Master of Business Administration (e-Business) - Executive M.B.A. (e-Business) - u għandhom jinqraw u jinfteħmu bhala haġa waħda mar-Regolamenti ta' sena 2001 tal-Kors għall-Grad ta' Master of Business Administration - M.B.A. - Executive Master of Business Administration - Executive M.B.A. - u Executive Master of Business Administration (e-Business) - Executive M.B.A. (e-Business) - ippubblikati bhala Avviż Legali 304 ta' l-2001, li minn hawn 'il quddiem jissejħu "ir-regolamenti prinċipali".

Applikabilita'

2. Dawn ir-regolamenti għandhom japplikaw għall-korsijiet li jibdeu f'Ottubru 2002 jew wara.

Emenda għar-regolament 3 tar-regolamenti prinċipali

5. Minflok is-sotto-paragrafu (a) tal-paragrafu (1) tar-regolament 3 tar-regolamenti prinċipali għandu jidhol dan li ġej:

“(a) grad ta’ Bachelor fil-Commerce jew fl-Accountancy b’mill-anqas it-tieni klassi bl-umuri minn din l-Universita’ jew kwalifika ekwivalenti; jew”

Żieda tal-paragrafi (4) u (5) mar-regolament 5 tar-regolamenti prinċipali

4. Il-paragrafi (4) u (5) li ġejjin għandhom jizdeddu wara l-paragrafu (3) tar-regolament 5 tar-regolamenti prinċipali:

“(4) Studenti li jehlu wara valutazzjoni mill-ġdid f’taqsima ta’ studju fil-Kors ta-Tranzizzjoni jistgħu jithallew jgħaddu proviżorjament għall-Ewwel Parti tal-Kors u jerġgħu jsegwu u jkunu valutati fih darb’ohra biss. Jekk ma jgħaddux, dawn l-istudenti ma jithallewx ikomplu l-Kors.

(5) Studenti li wara valutazzjoni mill-ġdid jehlu f’zewġ oqsma ta’ studju jew aktar tal-Kors ta’ Tranzizzjoni ma jithallewx ikomplu l-Kors.”

Emenda għar-regolament 9 tar-regolamenti prinċipali

5. Minflok il-paragrafu (1) tar-regolament 9 tar-regolamenti prinċipali għandu jidhol dan li ġej:

“9. (1) L-Ewwel Parti tal-Kors tinfirex fuq żewġ semestri, li matulhom l-istudenti għandhom isegwu taqsimiet studju magħzula mill-oqsma ta’ studju li ġejjin, kif mitlub mill-Bord:

L-Ewwel Stadju:

- (a) Accounting and Finance
- (b) Organisational Behaviour

- (c) Management Information Systems
- (d) Operations Management
- (e) Human Resource Management
- (f) Marketing Management
- (g) Information Systems Management
- (h) e-Commerce and e-Programming
- (i) Service Management”

Course (Amendment) Regulations, 2003**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 30(5) and 31(6) of the Education Act (Cap. 327), the Chancellor of the University of Malta has promulgated the following regulations made by the Senate of the University of Malta by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by sections 31 and 35 of the said Act:

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Master of Business Administration - M.B.A., Executive Master of Business Administration - Executive M.B.A. and the Executive Master of Business Administration (e-Business) - Executive M.B.A.(e-Business) - Degree Course (Amendment) Regulations, 2003 and shall be read and construed as one with the Master of Business Administration - M.B.A., Executive Master of Business Administration - Executive M.B.A. and the Executive Master of Business Administration (e-Business) - Executive M.B.A.(e-Business) - Degree Course Regulations, 2001, published as Legal Notice 304 of 2001, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

Applicability

2. These regulations shall be applicable for courses starting in October 2002 or later.

Amendment of regulation 3 of the principal regulations

3. For sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of regulation 3 of the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following:

“(a) a Bachelor’s degree in Commerce or in Accountancy with at least second class honours from this University or equivalent qualification; or”

Addition of paragraphs (4) and (5) to regulation 5 of the principal regulations

4. The following paragraphs (4) and (5) shall be added after paragraph (3) of regulation 5 of the principal regulations:

“(4) Students who after re-assessment fail in one study-unit of the Transition Course shall be allowed provisionally to proceed to Part One of the Course and to follow and be assessed again once only. If unsuccessful, such students shall not be allowed to proceed with the Course.

(5) Students who after re-assessment fail in two or more study-units of the Transition Course shall not be allowed to proceed with the Course.”

Amendment of regulation 9 of the principal regulations

5. For paragraph (1) of regulation 9 of the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following:

“9. (1) Part One of the Course shall extend over the first two semesters, during which students shall follow study-units chosen from the following areas of study, as directed by the Board:

Stage One:

- (a) Accounting and Finance
- (b) Organisational Behaviour
- (c) Management Information Systems
- (d) Operations Management
- (e) Human Resource Management
- (f) Marketing Management
- (g) Information Systems Management
- (h) e-Commerce and e-Programming
- (i) Service Management”
