## PRODUCT SAFETY ACT (ACT No.V OF 2001)

## **Dangerous Substances and Preparations (Restrictions)** (Amendment) Regulations, 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Economic Services has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:

- 1. The title of these regulations is the Dangerous Substances and Citation. Preparations (Restrictions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Dangerous Substances and Preparations (Restrictions) Regulations, 2002, hereinafter referred to L.N. 142 of 2002. as "the principal regulations".
- 2.1 For point 7 of the First Schedule, there shall be substituted Amends the the following point:

"7. di-isononyl phthalate (DINP)

Not permitted in toys and childcare articles as placed on the market and intended to be placed in the mouth by children of less than three years of age, and made of, or in part made of, soft PVC, where the concentration of these substances is in excess of 0.1 % by weight.

For the purposes of this point, the following definitions shall apply:

'toy' shall mean any product designed or clearly intended for use in play by children,

'childcare article' shall mean any product intended to facilitate sleep, relaxation, the feeding of children, or sucking on the part of children.".
