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**L.N. 88 of 2003**

**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT  
(ACT No. V of 2001)**

**The Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2003**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Economic Services has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:

**1.** The title of this Order is the Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2003, and shall be read and construed as one with the Cosmetic Products Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations<sup>1</sup>.

**2.** In reference number 419 of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations, for the paragraphs –

Amends the Second Schedule to the principal regulations.

“(a) the skull, including the brain and eyes, tonsils and spinal cord of:

– bovine animals aged 12 months;

– ovine and caprine animals which are aged over 12 months or have a permanent incisor tooth erupted through the gum;

and ingredients derived therefrom;

(b) the spleens of ovine and caprine animals and ingredients derived therefrom.”,

there shall be substituted the following :-

“From the date referred to in Article 22(1) of Regulation (EC) No 999/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council <sup>(i)</sup>, the specified risk materials as designated in Annex V to that Regulation, and ingredients derived therefrom.

Until that date, the specified risk materials as designated in Annex XI Part A to Regulation 999/2001, and ingredients derived therefrom.”.
