**A BILL**

**To amend the Civil Service Family Protection Scheme Act**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Civil Service Family Protection Scheme (Amendment) Act 2006.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the Civil Service Family Protection Scheme Act.

**3. Section 5 of the principal Act repealed and replaced**

Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and replaced by the following -

**5. Composition of the Board**

(1) The Board shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman and 7 other members of whom 2 shall be trade union representatives and not more than 2 shall be associates, appointed every 3 years by the Minister.

(2) The members of the Board shall hold office until 30 June of the third year from the year of appointment but shall be eligible for reappointment.

**4. Commencement**

This Act shall be deemed to come into operation on the 1 July, 2006.
