# A BILL

## To amend the Hindi Pracharini Sabha Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows -

## 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Hindi Pracharini Sabha (Amendment) Act 2009.

## 2. Interpretation

In this Act -

"principal Act" means the Hindi Pracharini Sabha Act.

# 3. Section 6 of principal Act amended

Section 6 of the principal Act is amended -

- (a) in subsection (2) -
  - (i) in paragraph (a), by deleting the words "each annual" and replacing them by the word "a";
  - (ii) in paragraph (b), by deleting the words "one year" and replacing them by the words "a period of 3 years";
- (b) in subsection (3), by deleting the words "an annual" and replacing them by the word "a".

## 4. Transitional provision

The members of the Committee in office at the commencement of this Act shall continue to hold office for the remaining period for which they have been elected.

## 5. Commencement

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.
