A BILL

To apply for a further sum of three billion two hundred and twenty-three million five hundred and two thousand and six hundred and three rupees (Rs. 3,223,502,603) to the service of the Government for financial year 2005-2006

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows -

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (2005-2006) Act 2006.

2. Appropriation of excess expenditure for 2005-2006

The sum of three billion two hundred and twenty-three million five hundred and two thousand and six hundred and three rupees (Rs. 3,223,502,603) consisting of the amounts specified in the Schedule, which was duly paid and applied to the services of the Government during the financial year 2005-2006, is declared to have been validly paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
