#### THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 94 of the Employment Relations Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Baking Industry (Remuneration Order)** (Amendment) Regulations 2015.
- 2. In these regulations –

"principal regulations" means the Baking Industry (Remuneration Order) Regulations 2003.

- **3.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1)(a), by deleting the words "Additional Remuneration (2014) Act 2013" and replacing them by the words "Additional Remuneration (2015) Act 2014".
- **4.** The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **5.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2015.
